

Renunciation & Deliverance Prayer for the Bastard Curse

A bastard shall not enter into the congregation of the Lord; even to his tenth generation shall he not enter into the congregation of the Lord. (Deut. 23:2).

Lord God, Heavenly Judge, I enter into Your courtroom because I long to be delivered from any possible demonic bondage that has entered through the sin of Deuteronomy 23:2, committed by me and/or my ancestors in the line of my father and mother back to Adam. I ask Your forgiveness for this sin of begetting illegitimate children.

I forgive these people for the consequences their actions have had on my life. For everyone within these generations who has hated You and not served You with joy, I ask You for forgiveness.

Lord Jesus, cleanse me with Your precious blood from all negative or destructive statements made before, during or after my birth. I cancel all these words and set myself free in the truth of God and the fullness of His plans for me.

Lord Jesus, for all my feelings of rejection, inability to love people, inability to worship in church, never feeling at home in church, I ask for Your help. Break this curse over my life and over the lives of my children. All the good things I have lost as a result of these curses, restore them in me.

In the name of Jesus I now command the demons that have entered my life as a result of the bastard curse described in Deuteronomy 23:2 to leave me now and go to the place where the Lord Jesus sends you!

(now pray concerning specific areas where you feel bondage: spirits of rejection, self-rejection, fear of rejection, neglect, abandonment, unworthiness, depression, despair, self-hatred, low self-esteem, fear of..., etc.)

Heavenly Father, I humbly ask that the blood of Jesus Christ, Your Son, will wash me from all sins that I have confessed and renounced, my spirit, my soul, my thoughts, my feelings, my conscience, my intuition, and every part of my body that has been affected by these sins. Fill me again with Your Holy Spirit. Amen.
